

Study Abroad in JAPAN

Documents Submission Period

- January semester : Apr. 1 – Sept. 15
- April semester : June 1 – Nov. 15
- July semester : Oct. 1 – Mar. 15
- October semester : Dec. 1 – May 15

*Only documents issued within the application period are valid

Class

- Morning class : 9:00 AM – 12:25 PM
- Afternoon class : 1:00 PM – 4:25 PM

The semester consists of 10-week study and 2-week break.

Tuition

Approximately ¥800,000 per year.

*It depends on the school. The center will help you.

Dormitory Fee

About ¥30,000 – ¥50,000 per month. Fees vary depending on the type of room and the number of students. The center will help you with the details.

Classes : 4 hours a day (5 days a week Mon-Fri)
