- Completed 12 years worth of education

Documents Submission Period

- March semester : Sept. 1 – Dec. 31
- June semester : Dec. 1 – Mar. 31
- September semester : Mar. 1 – June 30
- December semester : June 1 – Sept. 30

*Only documents issued within the application period are valid

Class

Classes are held 5 days a week (weekdays).

Tuition

Approximately ₩6,000,000 per year.

*It depends on the school. The center will help you.

Dormitory Fee

About ₩300,000 – ₩500,000 per month. Fees vary depending on the type of room and the number of students. The center will help you with the details. When you register for the dormitory, you must pay a deposit, facility fee, and insurance fee in addition to the rent. Typically, dormitory fees must be paid in units of 3 or 6 months.
